Welcome to the Summer term! This half term the school has decided on the whole school theme of 'On Location' with Class 2 choosing the 'Pirates of the Caribbean' as our film title to base our topic around.



In geography we will be comparing our local area with that of the old town of San Juan in Puerto Rico as well as looking at the weather from our local area, the equator and the Polar Regions. In history we will be learning all about the Jamaican born Mary Seacole and how she and Florence Nightingale helped during the Crimean War and compare these to how Edith Cavell assisted during World War 1.

In literacy we will start by looking at sea shanties and pirate poems and learn how to write our own different styles of pirate poems as well as working on performing these for other children in the school.

In science we will be looking at everyday materials and their uses and how some can be changed by squashing, twisting and stretching. Whilst in computing we will be focusing on writing and de-bugging algorithms using our bee-bots.

As well as number in maths we will be learning all about fractions, time and money and in RE will be learning all about creation and asking some 'Big Questions'.
