“New Year’s Resolutions”

Task: Complete a journal (or weekly log) which comments on how well you are doing at sticking to your New Year’s Resolution... or not, as the case may be!

Next week, the children of Class 3 will be discussing New Year’s Resolutions, so that each child will come up with a resolution for themselves, if they haven’t already done so! Following this, for their “optional extra homework task”, your child will keep a record of how well they feel they are sticking to the things that they have resolved to do.

The homework should include:

- 1) A clear statement about their chosen resolution, including an explanation as to why they chose it.
- 2) A journal or diary style record which reports on how well they are achieving (or not achieving) their resolution. This could be completed by hand or word-processor. It is not necessary to report daily; just every few days would suffice.
- 3) A final statement which sums up the progress that they are making with their resolution so far.

The homework could include:

- ~ Artwork inspired by your resolution (e.g. a collage of photos of you playing with and being kind to your younger sibling; a painting of you doing the washing up).
- ~ Perhaps make a calendar on which you write your resolution... so that you remind yourself about it for the whole year.
- ~ A table in which you score how well you are doing from day to day.
- ~ A poem which is inspired by your resolution.
- ~ Anything else you want that is relevant to your resolution and is appropriate to include.

Present your “journal” in any format you wish (PowerPoint, scrap book, file, video, etc.). Be as creative as you like! I look forward to reading them.
