- **Reminder - parents are allowed to take photos and video but strictly only for their own records. - **Christmas Crackers** – it's the school Christmas lunch on Thursday 21st December. If you are able to donate some Christmas Crackers by next Friday 15th it would be much appreciated. Thank you.
- **Christmas Parties** The children will be having their class Christmas Parties during the last week of term in the afternoon on the following dates: Tuesday 19th December for Class 1, Wednesday 20th December for Class 2 and Thursday 21st December for Classes 3 and 4. This year, school will purchase the food or drink for each party and we ask that each child brings in £1 towards the cost of this by next Friday 15th December please. Children may bring party clothes into school in a named carrier bag to change into after lunch on their party day.
- **Christmas Jumper Day.** On Friday 22nd December we will be raising money for Save the Children by holding a non-uniform day. Children can come in to school wearing a Christmas jumper or top with their normal school uniform for a donation brought to school on the day of a minimum of £1.00 per child. Do feel free to wear your Christmas jumper when you join us in Church!
- **End of term.** Please note that school closes at 2.30pm on Friday 22nd December. There will be a Carol Service at 1.15pm at Christ Church to which all are invited.
- **Current Nursery Parents – REMINDER** Your children are eligible to start in Reception class in September 2018. The deadline for applications is fast approaching and you must return

an application form and supplementary information form to school AS WELL AS submit your application online **by Monday 15th January 2018**. Failure to do so will mean that your application will be processed as a 'late' application and will be dealt with only after all other 'on time' applications have been awarded places. Forms and copies of the letter from North Yorkshire Admissions are available from the school office if you need a replacement copy.

- **If your child arrives in school late** ie after 8.40am for KS2, 8.50am for KS1 and Reception and 9.00am for Nursery they **MUST** enter school by the Main Entrance and be signed in by staff in the office. This is for their own safety and safeguarding so that they are correctly registered and so that a lunch can be ordered for them if necessary. Thank you for your assistance in this.
- **School lunch payments** If you pay for your child's school lunch please remember to make regular payments on the School Gateway so that your child's lunch money is always in credit. Thank you.
