- **Flu vaccinations reminder permission online** All children in Reception to Year 5 inclusive are being offered the flu vaccination this year. The permission form for this is online at www.hdff.nhs.uk/flu-consent school code 3PJ9Y and if you have not yet done so, please complete this form as soon as possible. The deadline for giving consent is this coming Wednesday 26th September and **consent given online after this date will not be processed and your child will not receive the vaccine at school.**

- **Playground developments** We are very excited that the work on our new playground developments will soon be under way! The contractors should be onsite sometime in October to take away the old trim trail and begin work on the new wildlife and activity area. There will also be some work carried out in the pre-school garden and in the area behind the school hall. We have been very lucky to get funding from the Allerton Park incinerator fund towards this project, but we have also had to find a considerable amount of money ourselves. I would like to thank you all for supporting Friends' events to help them raise the £10,000 which they have donated to the project and Georgina O'Connor who has managed to get a grant of £500 from Bettys. We have also been able to put £2,300 towards the project from our school's sports grant.

Privacy Policy Consent Form for 'The Friends' of Marton cum Grafton CE (VA) Primary School

The new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will apply in the UK from 25th May 2018. The 'Friends' is the term we use for the parents and carers of children at Marton cum Grafton CE (VA) Primary School.

As a PTA, the Friends hold certain information about you in order to contact you about upcoming events and other information from the Friends. This may include things such as asking for volunteers to help with upcoming events and holding a temporary list of volunteers or attendee details for a specific event.

In order to do this, we will hold your name, contact telephone number(s) and an email address for at least one parent of each family at the school. We will keep your personal data for as long as you are part of the 'Friends' of Marton cum Grafton CE (VA) Primary School after which time it will be destroyed if it is no longer required.

Please complete, sign and date the consent form sent last week and post it into the Friends post box which can be found by the main Reception or return it to Bianca Gaspar-Dunn (Chair of the Friends) – the deadline to do this is **Monday 1st October**.
