Shakespeare Rocks

Literacy

We will be learning about the features of non-chronological reports and writing reports, letters and adverts to link in with our science theme of animal habitats. There will also be practice of story writing, focusing particularly on setting the scenes and describing characters.

Maths

This term there will be a greater focus on geometry and measurement including time. Fractions will continue to be taught as well as the four number operations. We are having a big push on learning times table facts which is an important aspect to practise at home.

Science

We have one topic to cover this term which is Living Things and their Habitats. We plan to have lots of trips to the woods to help us with our studies and we look forward to using the new woodland classroom.

Geography

This will be a whole school topic with the theme 'On Location'. Each class will be studying a country from around the world as a vehicle for covering the aspects which we need to cover. We will then all come together to share our learning.

RE

Our theme for this is, 'What can we learn from stories shared by Christians, Muslims and Jews?'

PE

The class will be having some rounders lessons in preparation for a rounders tournament. They will also be playing Kwik Cricket, doing athletics and having some sessions of Outdoor and Adventurous Activities with Mr Jelf.

Art

Our theme for the art work we do this half term will be India.

Music

The main focus of music this half term will be singing (Shakespeare Rocks).
